

# Empathy towards Animals: Pre/Post Survey Protocol and Instruments

<b>Name of instrument</b>	<b>Empathy towards Animals: Pre/Post Survey</b>
<b>Use case and Target Audience</b>	Suggest for use with camp programs or other long-term programs with tween/teen audience: Ages 10-14 years old.
<b>Theme</b>	Survey to determine tween/teen's attitudes towards animals and whether or not this shifts as a result of experiencing empathy-related programming.
<b>Scheduled implementation</b>	Pre/Post over a minimum of one week, with preferred length of time of at least six months <b>Pre:</b> conducted prior to or at the start of the first day of the program <b>Post:</b> conducted after or on the last day of the program
<b>Evaluation questions addressed with assessment</b>	Does program participation impact tween/teen's empathy towards animals?
<b>Outcomes being measured</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Tween/teen's attitudes toward animals <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. Tween/teen shows compassionate concern for animals</li> <li>b. Tween/teen shows appreciation/respect for other animals</li> </ol> </li> <li>2. Tween/teen can take perspective of animals (feels that he/she can do so)</li> <li>3. Tween/teen demonstrates self-efficacy in relation to his or her ability to demonstrate caring behavior towards animals</li> </ol>
<b>Materials needed</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Survey</li> <li>• Pencil/pen</li> </ul>
<b>Data analysis plan</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Calculate the mean average score for each item; compare mean average scores between pre and post audiences (ideally, paired sample, requiring tween/teens to write in their birthdate for identification).</li> </ul>
<b>Staffing requirements</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 1 staff member required to distribute the survey to participants at start and end of experience. (Could also be used as online survey with tween/teens registering for camp.)</li> </ul>
<b>Time needed for activity</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 5-7 minutes</li> </ul>

## Protocol of Assessment Implementation:

Distribute survey to participants and have them spend a few minutes filling it out. It should take about 5-7 minutes to complete. Tell tween/teens them to complete the survey as best they can. They can leave items blank if they don't understand an item.
