The *Peep Explorer’s Guide* supplies Head Start teachers and other preschool educators with over 60 different activities across adaptable themes, including: Shadows, Water, Plants, Colors, Sound, and Ramps. Aligned with the Head Start Child Outcomes Framework.

The *Peep Event Kit* provides libraries, museum professionals, and public television outreach managers with resources to organize three different PreK science events, including how to set up hands-on activities, a promotional flyer, and family take-home materials in English and Spanish. Events focus on Structures, The Way Things Move, and Shadows.

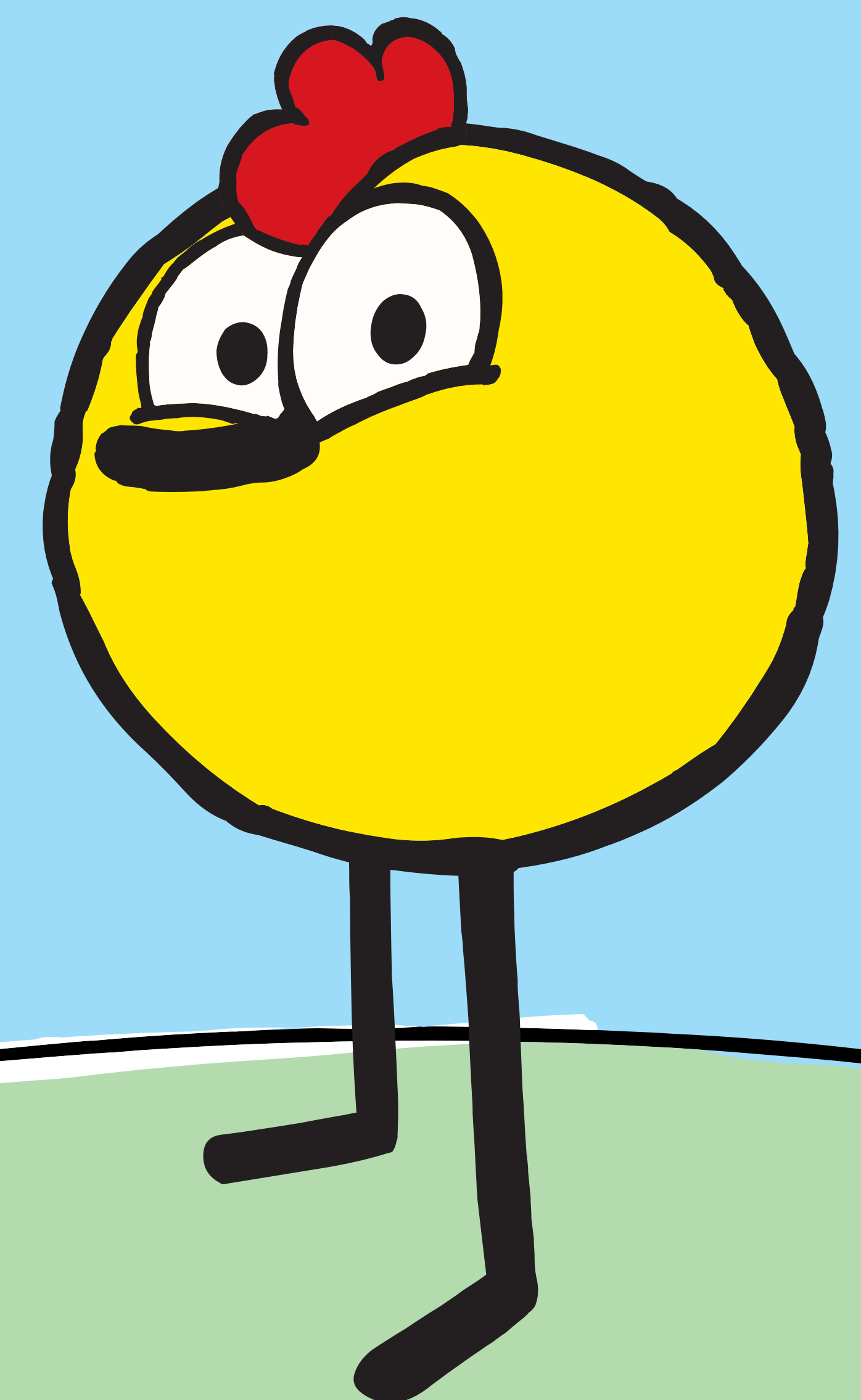
